

Butterfly Pencil Topper

Materials:

- Construction paper or craft fun foam sheets
- Paper to make a template
- Pipe cleaners or chenille stems
- Glue
- Scissors
- sequins, buttons or other ornaments





How to Make It:

Take a blank piece of paper and fold it in half. On the fold, draw a heart shape without the point at the bottom [the point would extend beyond the fold]. Look at the picture of the template shape above to see what this should look like [#1] –when you open it up it should look like a butterfly! [#2]

Once you're happy with the shape, use it as a template to trace on construction paper or fun foam. Cut this shape out.

Now fold the shape in half and make two small slits close together, in the center as shown. This is where your pencil will fit.

Decorate your butterfly pencil topper with cut out shapes, glitter, sequins or whatever you want.

Insert a pencil through the two slits.

Take a pipe cleaner and cut it in half. Twist around the front of the pencil and in front of the butterfly and make a loop at the tip of the antennas.
